1. Print your name and address clearly in the space provided. Be sure to use the same name and spelling each time.
2. The answer for each question will be found in the lesson or in the Bible references. You may look at the lesson and the Bible as you answer these questions.
3. You will find two or more answers after each question. Only one answer is correct. Write the letter of the correct answer on the line beside the question. Study the example given below until you understand clearly how you should answer.

#### EXAMPLE:
